WHAT WE NEED

- Turkey's = 25 (WE NEED BY MONDAY 11/25 if they're NOT cooked, must be thawed)
- Dinner Rolls = about 500
- Green Bean Casserole = about 25 in 13 x 9 pans
- Already prepared fresh pies (bought or homemade) = about 40
- Mixed Greens = 40 (27 oz. cans)
- Corn = 10 cans (6.3 pound cans)
- Yams = 15 cans (7 pound cans)
- Boxed Mashed Potatoes = 10 boxes
- Bottles of Turkey Gravy = about 50 bottles
- Chicken Broth = 7 cartons
- Butter = 8-10 pounds
- Milk = 5 gallons
- Silverware = 500
- Aluminum Foil
- Aluminum Trays
- Large Crockpots to heat up gravy = need 2
- Roasters to heat up food = need 9
- Paper grocery bags = 200
