WHAT WE NEED

- -Turkey's = 25 (WE NEED BY MONDAY 11/22. Must be thawed and uncooked)
- -Dinner Rolls = about 600
- -Green Beans = 80 cans
- -French Fried Onions =21 -16oz bags
- -Cream of Mushroom Soup= 28 cans
- -Already prepared fresh pies (bought or homemade) = about 40
- -Corn = 10 cans (6.3 pound cans)
- -Yams = 15 cans (7 pound cans)
- -Boxed Mashed Potatoes = 20 boxes
- -Bottles of Turkey Gravy = about 50 bottles
- -Stuffing = 20 boxes
- -Chicken Broth = 7 cartons
- -Aluminum Foil
- -Aluminum Trays
- -Paper grocery bags = Large and Medium size, 200 each
