WHAT WE NEED

- Turkey's = 25 (WE NEED BY MONDAY 11/19 if they're NOT cooked)
- Dinner Rolls = about 500
- Green Beans = 42 cans (15 oz. cans)
- Cream of mushroom soup = 24 (26 oz. cans)
- French's fried onion (topping) = 10 boxes
- Already prepared fresh pies (bought or homemade) = about 35
- Mixed Greens = 35 (27 oz. cans)
- Stuffing = 30-40 boxes
- Cranberry Sauce = 15 cans
- Corn = 7 cans (6.3 pound cans)
- Yams = 15 cans (7 pound cans)
- Boxed Mashed Potatoes = 30-40 boxes
- Butter = 8-10 pounds
- Bottles of turkey gravy = about 50 bottles
- Styrofoam "Togo" containers = 300
- Lawry's seasoning
- Aluminum Foil
- Aluminum Trays
- Large Crockpots to heat up gravy = need 2
- Roasters to heat up food = need 9
