SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

Search and Rescue is focused on helping homeless and at-risk veterans and their families get into housing if unsheltered or prevent them from becoming homeless if at-risk. For unsheltered veterans, our teams go out into the streets of our community to locate them and provide basic needs (food, outdoor gear, etc...) to address the immediate burdens of homelessness.

From there we connect them to the VA, housing agencies, and benefits application specialists to get their medical needs addressed, housed and on a path to self-sufficiency. For at-risk veterans, we review their financial and legal situation, work with landlords to pause evictions, help them secure financial assistance needed to keep them in their homes, and work with pro bono attorneys to resolve legal issues as applicable that are preventing a stabilized life.



We have many volunteer opportunities throughout the year that span from working directly with veterans in case management, to leadership roles in the organization.

Everyone's ability to help is unique. Although the ways to help and volunteer vary greatly, each of our volunteers impacts the lives of the veterans we serve, and each is appreciated for their efforts!

When you're homeless, without a consistent place to get rest, keep clothes clean, and regularly keep up with personal hygiene; obtaining and maintaining meaningful employment is extremely difficult. Additionally, without identification or a mailing address, applying for employment and benefits is difficult as well. To address these issues, our

Supportive Housing Program provides transitional housing to homeless veterans and their families.

The program can house 17 individuals at one time in one of 4 properties located in Brevard County.

During their stay, the veterans are assisted with developing individualized plans to get them back on their feet again; focused on reducing barriers to self-sufficiency such as medical, legal, financial, and substance abuse issues.

The ultimate goal of the program is to return the veteran and their family into society proud, self-sufficient, and securely housed; as a result, we do not impose an arbitrary expiration date for their stay so long as they are actively working toward their goals.
