National Veterans Homeless Support (NVHS) is a dedicated non-profit organization committed to eliminating homelessness among veterans by providing housing solutions and supportive services that lead to self-sufficiency.

## A Year of Direct, Measurable Support

### Veterans & Families Served

- **359** Veterans and their dependents assisted
- **103** veteran households prevented from becoming homeless through financial assistance and case management

### Seasonal Support Programs

- Christmas Assistance
  - **143** Veterans and **55** dependents supported
  - Served those living in transitional facilities or identified as low-income or at-risk
  - Provided essential supplies, clothing, and holiday gifts for children across Brevard County
- Thanksgiving Outreach
  - **396** meals prepared and delivered
  - Served homeless and low-income Veterans and their families throughout Brevard County

# Introducing Our 2026 Annual Corporate Giving Program

Introducing our 2026 Annual Corporate Giving Program. One structure, purpose-driven support. NVHS is simplifying how organizations partner with us by moving away from fragmented, event-by-event sponsorships toward a primary annual partnership model. This approach enables organizations to make a single, intentional commitment that supports NVHS throughout the year while receiving recognition aligned with who they are and how they serve the veteran community.

Partners benefit from consistent, multi-channel visibility. NVHS reaches **150,000+** annual website users, **5.9K** Facebook followers, and **2,850** email subscribers, with additional exposure through signature events, including **144** golfers at our annual tournament, **500+** community leaders and elected officials at our gala, and **400+** runners with podium recognition before **400+** attendees at our annual 5K.

Annual Partnerships are our preferred path for engagement, while event participation and one-time support remain available and welcome. All NVHS partners participate through one shared annual tier structure, with recognition applied through two distinct partnership lanes, ensuring clarity, respect, and alignment for both corporate supporters and mission-driven organizations.

## Annual Partnership Levels

Annual Partners support NVHS as an organization, not just a single event.

**Corporate Partner** — \$1,000+

Entry-level annual support with year-round acknowledgment.

**Community Partner** — \$2,500+

Visible support with meaningful event alignment.

**Mission Partner** — \$5,000+

Our most common partnership level, offering strong visibility and engagement.

**Impact Partner** — \$10,000+

Podium acknowledgment + premium program placement

**Guardian Partner** — \$25,000+

Leadership-level partners anchoring multiple events and initiatives.

**Patriot Partner** — \$50,000+ (Limited number)

Transformational partners with organization-wide impact and exclusive opportunities.

### What Your Partnership Can Look Like at Our Events

Annual Partnerships include opportunities to align with NVHS events throughout the year.

The examples below illustrate how partnership levels may be reflected across key events.

### Example Event Alignment by Tier

*(Illustrative — not a menu)*

- **\$1,000 Corporate Partner**

Logo on event website, sponsor banner, limited participant entries, one event alignment

- **\$2,500 Community Partner**

Expanded event presence, entries, signage, and grouped recognition, one event alignment, additional event entries

- **\$5,000 Mission Partner**

Featured visibility, announcer recognition.

- **\$10,000 Impact Partner**

Multi event alignment with one primary and secondary received Community Partner benefits

- **\$25,000 Guardian Partner**

"Presented by" naming rights. Supporting presence at 2 secondary events at the Community Partner level

- **\$50,000 Patriot Partner**

Premier listing as top NVHS Sponsor. Presence at all 3 main events with "Presented by" naming rights for one event

- On-site and digital visibility throughout the event
- Select award alignment opportunities (limited)
